INDEPENDENT CONTRIBUTOR GUIDE



The Independent Contributor Guide directs participants step-by-step through conducting an oral history interview; writing, editing, and publishing their veteran's service story in *Since You Asked*, and preserving the recorded interview in the Library of Congress. Video tutorials, interview questions, and writing worksheets are some of the supportive curriculum materials.

TWO WAYS TO PARTICIPATE

- ★ Work independently, with the opportunity to have our Program Staff and Editorial Committee review your writing and provide feedback.
- ★ Set up a private course for your own group of contributors (minimum of three participants) and track everyone's progress with moderator access.
